Remind us of its cost, Lord – the priceless blood of Your Son – and keep us humble and thankful for Your grace.

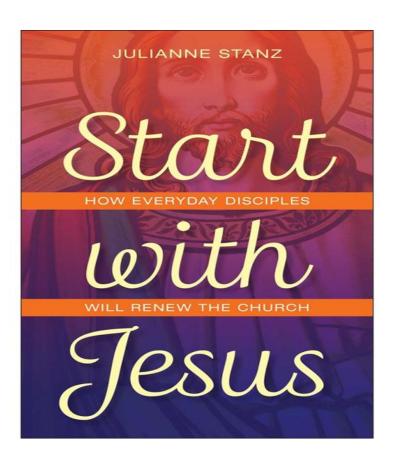
Encourage us to live in love even when we don't want to.

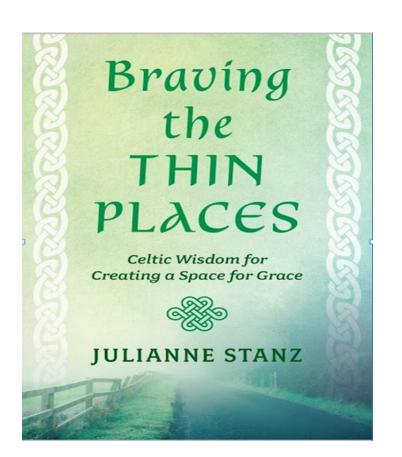
